Mercy College would like to award a grant for the above amount. Upon receipt of the signed Letter of Intent, formal notification of the terms of this grant will be provided by the Office of Admissions and the Office of Student Services. All offers of Admission and Financial are conditional pending receipt of official documents and upon successful completion of any work in progress.

The period of the scholarship is for one year. The limiting of this aid to one year is in accordance with the NCAA Constitution, which binds all member institutions. The award also conforms to and is subject to the rules and regulations of Mercy College. The continuation or non-renewal notice of scholarship will be made on or before July 1 prior to an academic year.

This grant is contingent upon the student-athlete's participation in the sport for which the grant is awarded. In the case of injury that will not allow the student-athlete to participate, the grant will be continued so long as the student remains academically eligible. It is required that you notify Mercy College of any pre-existing injuries or illness. Mercy College may request that you be evaluated by our physicians at the time of notification, if necessary. Furthermore, the student-athlete must remain in good academic standing, abide by all Mercy College regulations including, but not limited to those found in the Student and Residential Life Handbooks, and cannot be on disciplinary probation.

Institutional aid is based on family need as calculated annually using data submitted on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the NYS TAP Applications. All information on these forms is subject to verification. The amount of need, and therefore, the financial aid, may fluctuate from year to year, since changes in the family financial situation could impact the amount of the athletic grant.
